I. Transform the following according to the instructions.

1. Shuumatsu ni dokoka e ikimashita ka? [more polite]
shuumatsu ni dochiraka e irasshaimashita ka
2. Kono puraza ni wa pan-ya to niku-ya dake arimasu. [use *shika*]
kono puraza ni wa pan-ya to niku-ya shika arimasen
3. Kondo no shiken wa yasashii desu. [probably ...]
kondo no shiken wa yasashii deshoo
4. Nihongo no jisho wa asoko ni arimasu. [more polite]
Nihongo no jisho wa achira ni gozaimasu
5. Ginkoo wa suupaa no tonari ni arimasu. [shorter version]
Ginkoo wa suupaa no tonari desu
6. Kanji no benkyoo o tetsudaimasu. [Shall I ...?]
Kanji no benkyoo o tetsudaimashoo ka

4. In Victoria there were many tourists.
Bikutoria ni wa kankookyaku ga oozee imashita
5. The museum was very good in particular.
Toku ni hakubutsukan wa totemo yokatta desu
